



# Flower 1.

# Felt Flowers Instructions.


Three layers of wool fibre.




Begin to felt with a small piece of bubble wrap laid in the top 1/3rd of the piece. This stops the layers felting together.

The finished flower.


# Flower 2.




Lay petals around in flower shape.  
Lay 2 layers in a small square over the centre.  
You can chop up some wool yarn and scatter into centre.



Make petal shapes by pulling out fibres and twisting the ends.



Using a green wool roll some into a stem leaving one end dry.




Back of flower. Spread unfelted end of stem out to felt into flower.

Wet flower and turn over to add the stem. Wrap the felted stem in a piece of plastic and continue to felt.

Piece of plastic  
or foam sheet

Lay out fibres as petals.  
Make sure there are wool fibres  
in centre. Cut a piece of plastic/foam  
sheet and cut a hole in the centre.  
Lay fibres over the plastic centre  
crossing the fibres.

Felt the whole flower concentrating on the centre.  
When the flower is felted pull out the plastic ring  
and make sure the centre petals are cut free.  
Cut the centre piece into petals.  
Continue to felt until the petals are firm and  
can be formed into shape.

Rinse well in clean water. Squeeze out water  
and arrange the petals, leave somewhere open to  
dry.
